

BARDONECCHIA SKI

The resort of Bardonecchia is a true paradise for skiers of all levels; its slopes are always in perfect conditions, and its comprehensive network of snow-guns contributes to the excellent maintenance of the runs. It's impossible to resist a descent of the Olympic Piste or one of the longest ski runs of the Alps (from 2,800 metres to 1,300 metres for an altitude difference of 1,500 metres). The entire ski area stretches over a variety of terrain with plenty of slopes that weave through the woods as well as slopes at a higher altitude above trees with breath-taking views over the surrounding mountains.

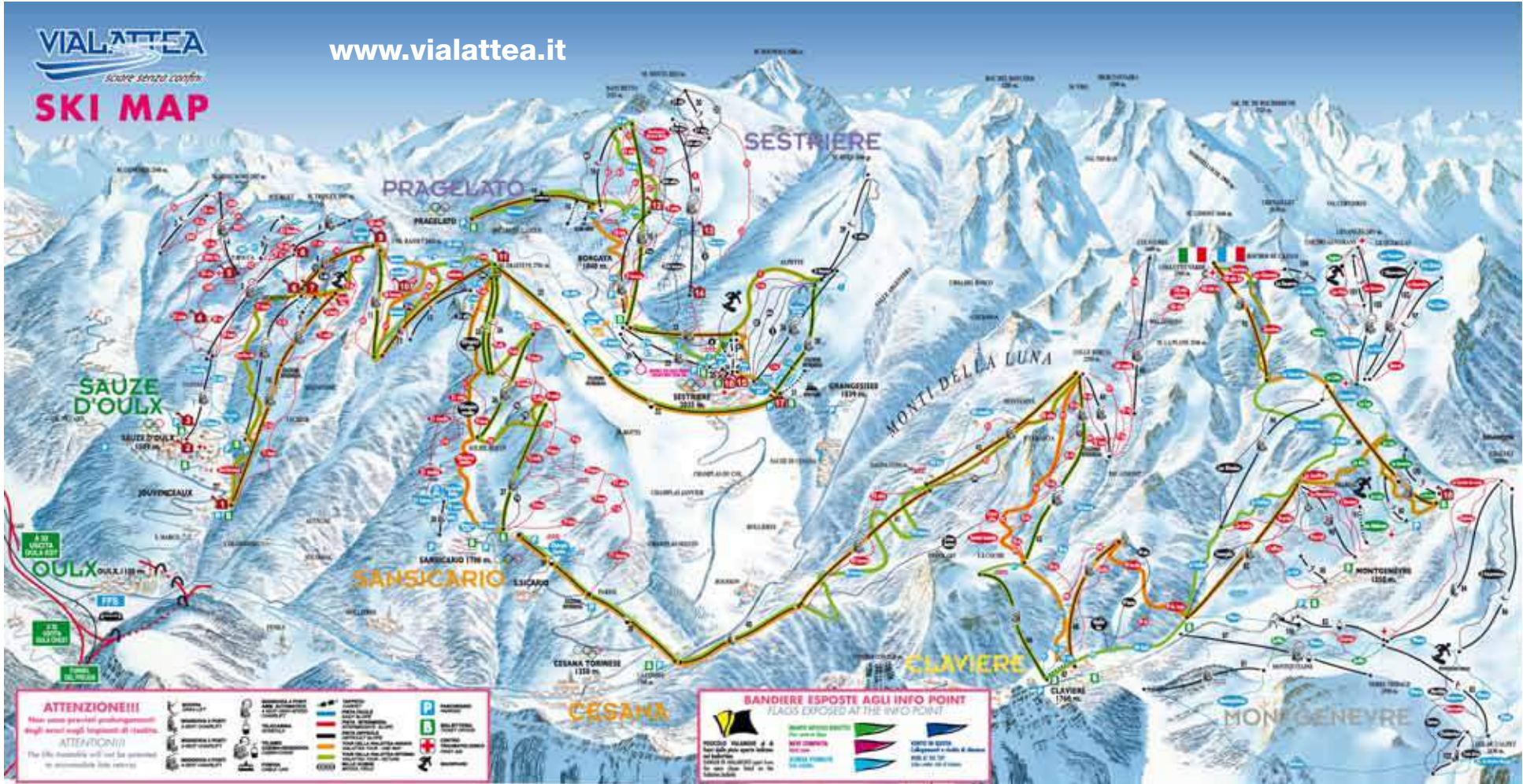

Nestled in a sunny valley and surrounded by stunning mountain peaks that reach heights of more than 3000 metres, Bardonecchia is one of the most picturesque corners of the entire Western Alps. It has been popular ski resort ever since the early 20th century and more recently it hosted the Turin Winter Olympics Games 2006 snowboard events. The resort is constantly evolving to keep up with the times but it has retained a great deal of character and offers visitors a perfect mix between tradition and modernity.

VIALATTEA

In Vialattea you can ski on the same slopes where the top champions skied during the XX Winter Olympics Torino 2006. The Vialattea skiing area is waiting for you to discover the infinite beauties and opportunities of the Alta Val Susa and Chisone: a completely renewed skiing area, with modern lifting facilities, pistes for beginners and slopes to challenge even the most advanced skiers, as well as a state-of-the-art programmed snow-making system.



SESTRIERE

THE BRIGHT STAR OF THE VIALATTEA CONSTELLATION

It's the bright star of the Vialattea constellation, an international ski resort since the 1930s. Sestriere has everything a modern winter holiday spot needs: a vast array of sports facilities, top class shopping, all sorts of amenities and nightlife opportunities. But this fashionable and very busy town hasn't lost its magic, thanks to the surrounding, unparalleled Alpine scenery.

WHERE ITALY AND FRANCE ARE JOINED

Located exactly where Italy and France are joined on the Vialattea, Claviere is a charming resort offering pristine snow and scenic ambience, with fine views of the imposing Mount Chaberton (elevation 3,131 metres - 10,272 feet). The spa centre and other wellness facilities are the perfect place to unwind after a day of skiing, or to spend the day if your favourite activity is... relaxation!

SAUZE D'OULX

THE "BALCONY OF THE ALPS"

Renowned as the "balcony of the Alps" because of its scenic position, Sauze d'Oulx offers wonderful skiing on groomed pistes through larch and fir woods. Mountain refuges serve traditional food and drinks and a warm welcome is guaranteed. It is the liveliest town of the Vialattea: a trendy and fashionable hotspot, where there is action day and night.

CESANA SANSICARIO

A TOP CLASS RESORT

Cesana Torinese, a top class resort, is one of the access points to Vialattea, the world famous ski area boasting 400 kilometres (250 miles) of pistes. There are two main villages in the Cesana community: San Sicario Borgo is the classical alpine old hamlet, among forests and majestic peaks. San Sicario Alto, right at the bottom of ski slopes, is at hand and ideal for skiing to the hotel door. Wilderness and isolated valleys are easy to reach from Cesana Torinese, for snowshoe excursions or backcountry skiing.

PRAGELATO

Pragelato is a highly important tourist centre in the heart of the Alta Val Chisone. It forms part of the Vialattea international ski area and is connected to it by cable car and a new piste that re-engages the skier in the hamlet of Pattemouche. Pragelato also offers endless possibilities for snowshoe hikers and a wide range of ski-mountaineering tours that allow you to safely enjoy the surrounding mountains at any time of the season and in every season of the year due to their usability and all year round beauty. With magnificent Nordic ski slopes immersed in stunning silence and the evocative landscapes of the Val Tronca Nature Park, Pragelato is truly the capital of cross-country skiing. Pragelato's 19 Alpine hamlets make it an unrivalled realm of sustainable and experiential tourism.
